

The Global Care-A-Thon Walkathon started in 1975 as a Sunday school initiative at Heimdal Community Church. At the time,

Kellert and Mamie Wenger were the Sunday school teachers and they asked the children what they could do to make Sunday school more interesting.

The idea of sponsoring a child in another country was suggested and these two Sunday school teachers took this suggestion seriously and the idea came to live.

Over the past 48 years the total amount raised for poor and needy children is just over \$2 Million dollars.

Throughout the years Hattie Kellert held many different roles: emcee, treasurer, board member, promoter, road patrol, ... always the first to arrive and the last to leave. No job was too big or too hard, there was always a way, rain or shine.

Even though these senior years have been hard for her because she cannot get out like she used to, she continues to gain sponsors for the Walkathon, raising thousands every year.

Although she cannot physically attend the board member meetings she is considered an honorary

member and we value her participation and support.

Her leadership, along with her husband Leo, has been instrumental in creating this unique charity that has helped so many children over the years.

This year we want to honour Hattie and her unwavering commitment and support for "the least of these".





We praise the Lord for all He has done through the Global Care-A-Thon Mission at FHI. For over forty-seven years, the Global Care-A-Thon Mission has been actively raising funds for vulnerable children around the world. It is amazing to see what He has done through this little church with a big heart! Every June, the kind folks at Heimdal Community Church volunteer their time and energy to host the walkathon and then collect sponsorships throughout the rest of the year. They have been a huge blessing to Father's House in Romania and South Africa, as well as Calcutta Mercy in India. We are so grateful for their hearts to serve and make this wonderful event happen, and for their generosity towards helping children in need. In 2022, Father's House International received \$18,000.00, because of their efforts. These funds will go towards supporting children

in our program and providing for their basic needs for food, clothing, and education. We are so grateful for their support and invite you to be a part of this wonderful event. You can donate, walk in the event and raise funds, or both!

Father's House in Romania began over 20 years ago by a dedicated Edmonton-area couple and has been helping Romanian families take in abandoned children ever since. An earlier political scheme had been determined to increase the population for military use, resulting in many children being abandoned.

In South Africa, many adults lost due to HIV/AIDS and tuberculosis, has left over 374,000 children to survive without parents. FHI operates in KwaZulu-Natal where 17% of the children are orphans, often living in child parented homes.

FHI is committed to helping place, and nurture, abandoned and orphaned children in Christian families. Living with loving families gives stability, life essentials and good role models for secure development. The sense of belonging and confidence grows in these children. We have

watched previously abandoned children thrive in these families and become contributing members of society as they grow up. FHI also has opportunity to provide Christian programming and spiritual guidance to youth in an orphanage in Romania. We have seen youth give their lives to Christ and have opportunities they never previously would have been able to. We praise God for all He has done through FHI and the partnership with the Global Care-A-Thon Mission.
